**Re. Year 13 Assessment Schedule: 12th to 30th April 2021**

As you know, after the Easter break, Year 13 students will complete assessments in many of their A Level and vocational subjects. These assessments will provide evidence which will contribute to students' final qualification grade.

The following pages contain a calendar of all assessments based at OSA for the first three weeks after the break, from Monday 12th to Friday 30th April. Students studying subjects at consortium schools should, in the first instance, check with their teachers when their assessments are scheduled. We are aiming to share a live consortium assessment schedule with the students when they return to school after the Easter break. We hope that students and parents will find this helpful for keeping track of the assessments to come, and for planning revision.

Due to further announcements and guidance being issued regularly by DFE and exam boards, the schedule attached may be subject to change, although we will do all we can to keep it consistent. Should any changes need to be made, we will let students and parents know as soon as possible.
